Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

Q1. Can I visit the Taipei office on a weekend?

A1. Most sources say the Taipei office is open Monday to Friday, and closed on weekends and public holidays.

Q2. What should I bring when visiting the office?

A2. Bring your booking reference or ticket number, passport/ID, any relevant receipts (e.g., for baggage fees or changes), and clearly explain what you need— e.g., baggage allowance clarification, upgrade request, etc.

Q3. Is the Taipei office also handling airport-counter issues at Taiwan's main airport?

A3. The office is separate from the airport check-in counters, but it can direct you or help with issues like baggage, check-in difficulties or liaison with the airport. For example: You may still need to go to the airport counter for your actual boarding pass.

Q4. Who do I call if I need immediate help outside office hours?

A4. If the Taipei office is closed, use the main customer service or the HQ number: +1-844-238-2070. Also check their global “Contact Us” section on the Spirit Airlines website for region-specific numbers.

Final Thoughts

By having the Taipei office information, you're better positioned to resolve flight, booking or baggage queries locally in Taiwan. If anything is escalated or involves global policy, the headquarters in Doha provides the higher-level backup. Whenever possible, call ahead to ensure the office hours are current (especially around public holidays) and bring all relevant documentation for a smoother interaction.
